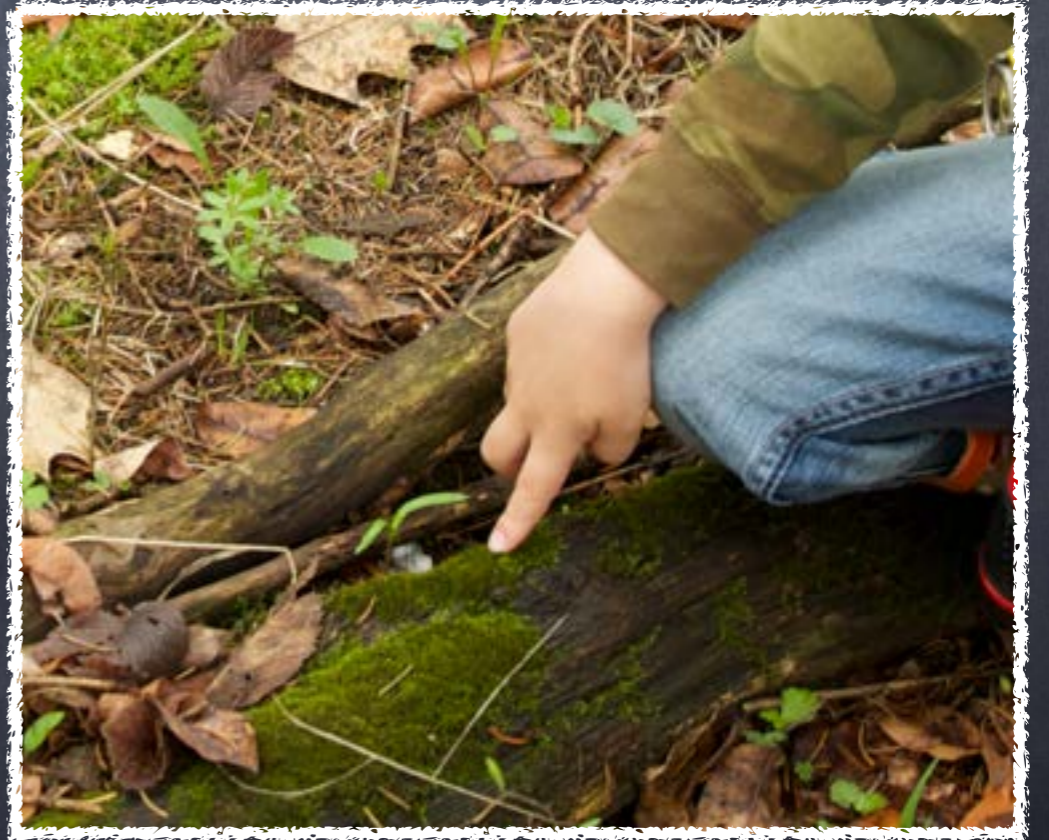
Entrance
